How will a NOAA Habitat Conservation Calculator Impact Your Port's Routine Maintenance?

How will application of NOAA's change to environmental baseline and increased mitigation through use of habitat conservation calculators nationwide significantly impact a port's ability to perform routine maintenance? NOAA Fisheries developed the Puget Sound Nearshore Conservation Calculator tailored to Puget Sound with a new "baseline" that no longer considers the existing structure as part of the environmental baseline and now requires compensatory mitigation for the enduring effects of existing permitted structures in addition to the maintenance action. This has resulted in higher costs as much as 30% to maintain existing authorized infrastructure. In January 2022, the Corps of Engineers, and the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) adopted these changes in a joint memorandum which states the new baseline will apply nationwide. This bonus session of the Harbors and Navigation Committee will focus on how NMFS' Puget Sound Nearshore Conservation Calculator does not align with the nature of ports and what implementation of conservation calculators nationwide would mean to ports in other regions.
